



LELAND TOWNSHIP CONSUMER FIREWORKS ORDINANCE

To all Leland Township residents, guests, and visitors –

Leland Township has adopted a Fireworks Ordinance that will regulate the use of Consumer Fireworks in the following manner:

- The ignition, discharge and use of consumer fireworks in Leland Township is prohibited at all times except for the day preceding, the day of, and the day after a National Holiday.
 - A person shall not ignite, discharge or use consumer fireworks on public property, school property, church property or the property of another person, without that person or organization's express permission to use the consumer fireworks on those premises.
 - The person shall not use consumer fireworks while under the influence of alcoholic beverage, a controlled substance or other intoxicating substance.
 - Consumer fireworks shall be used only in accordance with all applicable local, state and federal laws.
- Violators of any provision of this Ordinance shall be responsible for a municipal civil infraction and shall be subject to a fine up to \$500.00, plus costs and assessments. Each day this Ordinance is violated shall be considered as a separate violation.
